When applied, the colors make an immediate impact due to their purity. Many artists abandon paint brushes altogether in favor of the semi-flexible palette knife to create paintings that are full of rich texture and sweeping blends of color.

Class fee includes palette knives and a variety of acrylic paint. Students must provide their own small size canvas. The instructor purchases large canvas in bulk. Cost will be provided when canvas are ordered. There is currently a shortage of larger stretched canvas and prices vary. Current Price for 36" x 36" 1-1/2 gallery wrap canvas at bulk price is \$57/each.

Class 1: Artwork Creation - March 14, 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm

Class 2: Texturizing with Quilting or Decorative Stitches - March 22, 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm

Use leftover fabric scraps to create one-of-a-kind art suitable for display in the Art League's "Recycle Exhibit" beginning at the end of March, 2023. Join local Fabric Artist, Denise Harlan, as she guides you through how to use small leftover pieces of fabric to create your artistic masterpiece from fabric snippets. During Class 1, learn how to layer the fabric pieces and fuse them onto the background fabric to create landscape, still life or contemporary art. During Class 2, learn how to add surface texture to your artwork via quilting or decorative stitches.

Experience Required: No sewing experience necessary to create the artwork during class 1 while some familiarity with sewing is a plus for class 2.
